- ♣ Students must register their cars with the Deputy Principal
- ♣ Students must possess a full driving licence
- ♣ The Rules of the Road apply on school grounds
- ♣ Students may not drive out of the school during school hours, including lunch time
- Left Cars are off limits during the day
- Students may not carry other passengers (other than sisters) in their cars
- ♣ The Principal reserves the right to decline parking permission to a student should circumstances so dictate
